

## Welfare Schemes For The Farmers

Mandi Parishad has started various Welfare Schemes for the development programmes of the New Mandi Areas & Places keeping in mind the benefit of the Farmers.

### **Barn Fire Help scheme:**

Under recognized Mandi Areas of Uttar Pradesh, any damage done by fire to the Crop/ produce/some part of the crop kept in Barn can be reimbursed by the scheme run by Sub District Magistrate.

#### **(a) Work Area of the Scheme:**

Damage done to the crop kept in Barn normally for 45 days & In the odd weather for 60 days, for some external reason or accident or fire by lightening. All the Mandi Areas listed by Mandi Parishad in Uttar Pradesh.

#### **(b) Period:**

From date 01.07.2005.

#### **(c) Payable Amount:**

The amount shall be payable as per the crop area as per the following details:

Crop Area	Payable Amount
<b>(a) Marginal Farmer:</b> Owner of upto 1 Hectare i.e. 2.5 Acre Land.	Maximum Rs. 15000/- or actual inspected damage whatever is less.
<b>(b) Small farmer:</b> Owner of 1 to 2 Hectare i.e. 2.5 Acre to 5 Acre Land.	Maximum Rs. 20,000/- or actual inspected damage whatever is less.
<b>(c) Normal farmer:</b> Owner of 2 Hectare or more than 5 Acre Land.	Maximum Rs. 30,000/- or actual inspected damage whatever is less.
<b>(d)</b> In addition to the above, farmer's crop fire accident help scheme has been added in Barn fire help scheme and it has been decided to authorize DM of districts for claim settlement of fire accident where calculated sum of help amount is more than One Lakh.	

#### **(d) Process for Claim Completion:**

- 1 The related farmer/ manufacturer should produce the prescribed format( free application form which is available in Mandi Samaiti's office.) to the Sachive/Sabhapati, Mandi Samiti within 15 days of the accident.
- 2 The inspection for the received claim shall be done by sachive, Mandi Samiti & after completing the inspection work within a week, the last report shall be produced to the Sabhapati, Mandi Samiti on the prescribed format.
- 3 The claim shall be checked by Mandi Samiti Office & the payments shall be issued by Sabhapati after getting the approval from District Magistrate

& the payments shall be given by Sachive Mandi Samiti in the form of crossed check

- 4** All the above said procedure shall be completed in a month. In some special cases this time limit can be increased by the District Magistrate.
- 5** Mandi Samiti shall make the payments by Cheque.
